

**CITY OF CORINTH  
PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION**

The Public Utilities Commission was created by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Corinth on June 7, 1954, under authority of Chapter 494 of the General Laws of Mississippi of 1950.

The Commission is composed of 5 commissioners, appointed initially for terms of one to five years so that one commissioner's term expires each year; all subsequent appointments or re-appointments are for a term of 5 years, unless otherwise provided by law.

The Public Utilities Commission controls the operations of the City of Corinth Gas and Water Department.
